- iii. ENGAGE — How do The Ten Commandments address atheism, agnosticism, and idolatry? What do people in our culture tend to worship, and how do they express that worship?
- iv. EXALT — How is jealousy a virtue in God but generally a vice in humans? Why is it good for God to demand His own worship and defend His own glory? Why is it important to remember that God delivered Israel from slavery first, then gave The Ten Commandments?
