Study Questions for the Week:

I. EQUIP — Looking back at your notes from this week's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or something that caught your attention, challenged you, or encouraged you? Read the following passages (Matt 22.37; Mark 12.29–30; Luke 10.27), especially noting their surrounding context. How does Jesus use The Shema?

II. ENGAGE — Who has been a person in your life who instructed you in the faith? How did they teach you about the LORD — through words or through actions or both? What role did the church play? What role did your parents play? Who is someone you are ENGAGING in order to pass your faith on to them?

III. EXALT — What are things to which you turn for comfort during times of difficulty? What are things to which you turn for celebration during times of blessing? How do you grow in your love for the Lord? What are practical ways to remember and EXALT Him throughout your day?
