Weekday Application Questions

I. EQUIP — Read the following from our doctrinal statement and study the supporting Scriptures: “The Godhead.” We believe in one Triune God, existing in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, eternal in being, identical in essence, equal in power and glory and having the same attributes and perfections (*Deut. 6.4; 2 Cor. 13.14*).

II. ENGAGE — Two Jehovah’s Witnesses come to your house and insist that the Trinity is a logical impossibility and therefore must be false. How would you respond? Later, a few Mormon missionaries come knocking on your door. What is their view of the Trinity? How would you defend what the Bible says about the Trinity to them?

III. EXALT — Why is the subject of Trinity one of the most marvelous, and yet potentially the most dangerous, of all studies? How is it that God is both “revealed” to us and yet “mysterious” to us at the same time? How does this mystery lead us into a deeper sense of worship?
