Weekday Application Questions

I. EQUIP — Read the following from our doctrinal statement and study the supporting Scriptures: “**Salvation**. We believe that salvation is a gift of God in grace and is received by man through personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ whose precious blood was shed for the forgiveness of our sins (Eph. 2.8–9; John 1.12; Eph. 1.7). The Eternal Security of the Believer. We believe that all true believers, once saved, are kept secure in Christ forever (Rom. 8.1, 29, 30, 38–39; John 10.27–30).”

II. ENGAGE — Your unsaved neighbor asks you to explain Christianity to them. How would you use the terms “salvation,” “grace,” “faith,” “forgiveness,” and “eternal security” in your response? Why are each of these words important?

III. EXALT — How does being justified “by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone” draw you into a deeper and purer worship of God?
