Weekday Application Questions

I. EQUIP — Read the following from our doctrinal statement and study the supporting Scriptures: **"The Responsibility of Believers.** We believe that all believers should seek to walk by the Spirit, not bringing reproach upon their Lord and Savior, and that separation from worldly pleasures and practices is commanded of God (Rom. 12.1, 2; Gal. 5.16, 25; 2 Cor. 6.14; 7.1). We believe that it is the obligation of every believer to witness by life and by word to the truths of Holy Scripture and to seek to proclaim the gospel to all the world (Acts 1:8). We believe that it is the responsibility of all believers to remember the work of the Lord in prayer and to support it with their means as the Lord has prospered them (1 Cor. 16.2)."

II. ENGAGE — Your neighbor claims that she isn't a Christian because "Christians are all hypocrites." How do you respond? How is her assessment correct? How is her assessment incorrect?

III. EXALT — Have you presented your life to God as a sacrifice? Do you seek to "take up your cross daily and follow Him" (Luke 9.23)? What is an area of life that you need to surrender to Him?
