Weekday Application Questions

I. EQUIP — Read the following from our doctrinal statement and study the supporting Scriptures: "The Personality of the Holy Spirit. We believe the Holy Spirit is a person who convicts the world of sin, righteousness and judgment. He also in the present age regenerates believers in Christ, baptizes them into the church, the body of Christ, indwells them permanently, seals them unto the day of redemption, bestows spiritual gifts upon each one, and fills those yielded to Him (John 15.26, 27; 16.7–15; John 3.8; 1 Cor. 12.13; John 14.16; Eph. 4.30; 1 Cor. 12.4–11; Eph. 5.18)."

II. ENGAGE — Read Ephesians 5.18–21 and Galatians 5.16–23. Are you being filled with the Spirit? Is the fruit of the Spirit evident in your life? With what do you fill your life? Do people regularly see the fruit of the Spirit in your life?

III. EXALT — When have you been especially aware of the Holy Spirit's presence in your life? (i.e., using your spiritual gift, evangelism, Bible teaching, prayer, worship, suffering, etc.)? What made you aware of His presence?
