Weekday Application Questions

I. EQUIP — Read the following from our doctrinal statement and study the supporting Scriptures: "The Second Coming of Christ. We believe in the personal imminent coming of the Lord Jesus Christ for His own, the Church, and His subsequent premilllennial return to earth to set up His kingdom (1 Thess. 1.9, 10; 4.13-18; Zech. 14.4–11; Rev. 20.6). The Eternal State. We believe that the souls of those who have trusted in the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation do at death immediately pass into His presence, and there remain in conscious bliss until the resurrection of the body at His coming for the Church, when soul and body reunited shall be associated with Him forever in glory; but the souls of unbelievers remain after death in conscious misery until the final judgment of the great white throne at the close of the millennium, when soul and body reunited shall be cast into the lake of fire, not to be annihilated, but to be punished with everlasting separation from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power (Luke 16.19–26; 23.43; 2 Cor. 5.8; Phil. 1.23; 2 Thess. 1.7–9; Rev. 20.11–15)."

III. EXALT — Spend some time thinking about Jesus' future reign over the earth. What will it be like to have Jesus reign as the King? ...to physically approach His throne? ...to worship Him as a worldwide Church?
