## **Weekday Application Questions**

I. EQUIP — Read the following proposal to our doctrinal statement and study the supporting Scriptures: "The Spiritual Realm. We believe that God created sinless, spiritual beings commonly known as angels. A great company of these angels serve God at His throne and minister to mankind, especially believers. We believe that one of these angels, Satan, sinned through pride and led a host of other angels in rebellion against God. Satan subsequently tempted our first parents to sin, leading to their fall. Satan remains, today, the enemy of God and of God's people, actively opposing our efforts at godly worship and service. Although Satan was judged at the cross, he temporarily rules as the ruler of this world — as God allows. Ultimately, Satan will be eternally defeated and eternally condemned (Ps. 148.2–5; Isaiah 14.12–17; Ezek. 28.11–19; Eph 6.10–12; 2 Cor 4.4; Heb. 1.14; 1 Peter 5.8–9; Rev. 4.5–11; 20.1–3, 10)."

**II. ENGAGE** — How are angels and demons typically portrayed in movies and television shows? How are they portrayed in the Bible? What are the similarities? Differences? So what?

**III. EXALT** — How has God overcome our spiritual enemies and what difference does that make in our life today?
