Weekday Application Questions

I. EQUIP — Describe the basic procedure of the High Priest on the Day of Atonement (see Leviticus 16). How does Jesus' sacrifice surpass the work of the High Priest in the Temple (see Hebrews 9–10)?

II. ENGAGE — How have you seen people of other faiths (or no faith at all) try to make atonement for their sins? How does the Gospel provide the only answer to peoples' need for atonement? Pray for many people to come to faith in Jesus during Yom Kippur!

III. EXALT — What are some of the useful traditions associated with Yom Kippur? What are some of the misguided?
