Here is your "One Thing" for this week: If we want to Follow Jesus in a Fallen World, then we need to obey Jesus' Marching Order for us by humbly serving others. Whom are you serving? Whom can you serve?

Weekday Application Questions

I. EQUIP — What were the disciples discussing before Jesus washed their feet (Luke 22.24–27)? How does that background knowledge add to this scene?

II. ENGAGE — Jesus washes the disciples' feet as an "example" (13.15) for them (and us) to follow. When and why do you find it difficult to allow others to serve you? When and why is it difficult for you to serve others?

III. EXALT — When evaluating the responses of Peter and Judas, what is the contrast presented in the Text? What can we learn about EXALTing Jesus from Peter? What can we learn about betraying Jesus from Judas?
