<b>EQUIP</b> — Take some time to review Lamentations 4. In 4.1–10, follow the
contrasts before and after the siege. In 4.11–20, note the explanation for
Jerusalem's destruction. What is the basis for hope expressed in 4.21–22?

**II. ENGAGE** — Like the children in Lamentations 4, have you ever suffered because of someone else's sin? — AND — Has someone else ever suffered because of your sin? How?

**III. EXALT** — Read Luke 15.11–32 ("The Prodigal Son"). Which son do you most relate to from this parable? Why?
