

Dear Friends,






REBUILD RESTORE RENEW



REBUILD our Grace Kids Wing and our Family Picnic and Playground area. \$350,000


The REBUILD portion of the campaign focuses on remodeling two areas. The Grace Kids wing will be updated to provide five fully equipped classrooms designed especially for our Grace Kids Sunday programs. There will be windows in the hallways and the new classroom layouts are open, colorful, and bright, with ample space for activities. This project also includes remodeling four of our main bathrooms.

The second area is our outdoor playground and family area. This project will replace the old and worn-out equipment with new equipment, add a covered picnic area with access to a grill for cookouts, and provide an outdoor all-weather turfed play area. The entire area will be fenced for safety. It will be a great place for families to enjoy time together after church or for one of our small groups to gather. It will be an inviting and great place to come together for fun and fellowship.



RESTORE our Roof. \$150,000

The RESTORE project focuses on our roof. Our roof has been faithful to protect us from the elements, but there are portions that have lasted us more years than predicted and are now in need of attention. This project will address our roofing needs and restore them to proper health.



RENEW our Sanctuary, Commons, and Student Center. \$500,00

The RENEW portion of the campaign focuses on our Sanctuary, Commons, and Student Center. This project includes a new digital sound system for the Sanctuary along with new carpet. It also includes updating the flooring in the Commons, adding a new greeter station, new security station, new Equip Station, and a full-service coffee bar area. In addition, we will renew the Student Center with an updated lounge for meetings and small groups as well as update the Student Center meeting area with a new stage.
