Application Questions

Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible. It contains 176 verses broken into 22 stanzas that are based on the Hebrew alphabet. There are at least 178 references to the word of God. Furthermore, there are at least 18 Principles to Live By.

5 of Principles to Live By:

- 1. To experience true fulfillment, we must continually learn and apply the principles in the inspired word of God (119:1-8)
- 2. To experience hope and comfort in the midst of difficult circumstances we're to focus on God's promises (119:49-56).
- 3. To grow in wisdom and godliness, we should meditate on Scripture regularly. (119:97-104)
- 4. When we study the Scriptures, we should be both comforted by God's promises of protection and concerned when we disobey His commands. (119:113-120)
- 5. When we face crises in our lives we should pray earnestly and confidently using the word of God as a basis for our prayers. (119:145-152)
