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## Weekday Application Questions

**EQUIP** — Read our doctrinal statement and study the supporting Scriptures: "We believe that God commands Christians to love Him supremely and to love others sacrificially. We believe that we are citizens of heaven living in the world but no longer of the world and are new creations in Christ who are called to live markedly distinct and holy lives. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, in obedience to the Word of God, along with the practice of spiritual disciplines, and participation in the fellowship of the Church, the believer is enabled by God to live in conformity to the will of the Father, to become more like our Lord Jesus Christ, and to manifest the fruit of the Spirit. We believe that Christians are ambassadors of Christ, God's image-bearers in a fallen world, and are called to walk in the good works God has prepared for us. It is our responsibility to proclaim the gospel, to make disciples among the nations, and to glorify God in all that we do (Acts 1:8; Romans 12:1-2; First Corinthians 3:10-17, 10:31; Second Corinthians 5:20; 7:1; Galatians 5:16; Ephesians 2:10; 5:15-21; Philippians 4:8-9; Second Thessalonians 1:11-12; Titus 2:11-14; Hebrews 12:1-2, 14; James 1:27; First Peter 4:11; First John 3:1-10)."

**ENGAGE** — In what ways do people (believers or non-believers) seek glory? How do people try to rob God of His glory?

**EXALT** — In what ways do you observe people (believers or non-believers) worship things other than God? How does worship reflect our deep longing for meaning in life?
