EQUIP— How does Nebuchadnezzar’s story in Daniel 4 relate to the concept of humility and seeking God’s kingdom first, as mentioned in Matthew 6:33? How does Jesus model how to handle greatness? How has He used His life to serve others?

ENGAGE — How can someone who experiences great success in this world, like Nebuchadnezzar, remain humble? Can you think of people who have done this well? Who? How?

EXALT—What is God showing Nebuchadnezzar by making him animal-like? How did his “punishment fit the crime”? Describe a time when God has humbled you to get your attention. How did you respond to His work in your life?

Here is your “One Thing” for this week: Reflecting on Nebuchadnezzar’s experience in Daniel 4, how can you guard against pride in your own achievements and instead acknowledge God’s sovereignty in your life? How can you use your gifts, talents, and successes to serve God rather than yourself?

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
