## **Weekday Application Questions**

**EQUIP** — What is your emotion regarding the study of prophecy and the End Times? Are you excited, overwhelmed, intimidated, etc.? Have you ever been overwhelmed by Scripture, as Daniel was in this text? What were you reading, and why was it so powerful?
