6) Weekday Application Questions:

A) EQUIP — Using the Scripture as your resource, what do you know about the church in Ephesus? ... its history? ... its culture? ... its people? How would you summarize Jesus' message to the church in Ephesus? What good things does He say? What correction does He have for them?
