6) Weekday Application Questions

EQUIP — How does Jesus' message to Sardis compare and contrast with His messages to the other churches we've seen in Revelation?

ENGAGE — What was the reputation of the church in Sardis? Did its reputation match its true nature? How can a church have a good "name" but not have a good nature?

EXALT — Have you ever struggled with a disconnect between your "reputation" and your "reality?" In other words, have there been times in your life when you felt "dead" spiritually, but no one (other than Jesus) knew? What instruction do we see in this passage to address that disconnect?

Here is your "One Thing" for this week: How can you watch over your spiritual life so that you don't become apathetic in your faith? How does being "watchful" keep you spiritually vibrant?
