Weekday Application Questions

EQUIP — Ephesians 3:20-21 declares that God is able to do "far more abundantly than all that we ask or think." How does this truth align with other passages about God's power and faithfulness (e.g., Jeremiah 32:17, Matthew 19:26, 2 Corinthians 9:8)? Spend time reflecting on these verses. How does understanding God's limitless power strengthen your faith?

ENGAGE — Since God's power is at work within us (Ephesians 3:20), how should that encourage us to share the Gospel? Who needs to hear about the greatness of God's love and salvation? What specific step can you take this week to share Christ with someone?
