4) Weekday Application Questions

a) EQUIP — What does Revelation 12 reveal about Satan’s strategy? Why is it important to recognize that Satan is still active, even though his defeat is assured? How do the events in Revelation 12 correlate with passages like Genesis 3:15, Daniel 10, and Matthew 24?

b) ENGAGE — Many people do not believe in the spiritual realm (angels, demons, etc.). Why? Where do you see Satan at work in our world today? How does Jesus overcome Satan’s tactics in that area? How do we wrongly try to fix spiritual problems with human solutions?

c) EXALT — What aspects of God’s character are most clearly seen in this passage (e.g., His power, His protection, His faithfulness)? Theologically and practically, why and how is Jesus’ ascension (verse 5) important to our life today?

d) Here is your “One Thing” for this week: When you feel accused, defeated, or afraid, remember: you have an Advocate with the Father, and you have overcome because of the blood of the Lamb (verse 11). So, rejoice! What is one way you can cling to that truth this week?
