#### 4) Weekday Application Questions

**a) EQUIP** — How would you summarize Revelation 14 in one sentence? What is the main point of the passage? What other passages correspond to Revelation 14?

**b) ENGAGE** — If judgment is coming and grace is still being offered, who around you needs to hear the Gospel? Is there someone you've been hesitant to talk to about Jesus? Let Revelation 14 reignite your compassion and inspire a sense of urgency.

**c) EXALT** — The Lamb is victorious. His followers are protected. The angels sing. And the Judge of all the earth does what is right. Take a moment this week to meditate on the fact that the same Lamb who will one day reap the harvest of judgment is also the Lamb who was slain for you. Worship Him with reverence — and with joy.
