4) Weekday Application Questions:

- **a) EQUIP** How does God's promise to bless all the nations through Abraham shape your understanding of the Bible's global mission? See the whole Bible as one unified story that leads us into mission.
- **b) ENGAGE** What specific steps can you take to be a blessing to the nations? (Pray for an unreached people group, give sacrificially to missions, consider going—short-term or long-term). Join God's plan to bless the nations through prayer, giving, going, and sending.
- c) EXALT Praise God for His faithfulness across generations. Take time this week to thank God that someone brought the gospel to you—and ask Him to use you to pass it on. Worship the God who takes humanity's curse and turns it into worldwide blessing.
- d) Here is your "One Thing" for this week: God's answer to the curse, death, and wandering of this world is the blessing, life, and home promised to Abraham and fulfilled in Jesus and He calls us to share that blessing with the nations. You have been blessed to be a blessing. How will you reflect that blessing to others this week?
