Read Phil.4:4-6 and then focus on vs.6. The exhortation is to pray about everything but note the prepositional phrase "with thanksgiving". How much of our requests are to be saturated with thanksgiving? How then can we develop a more thankful approach to our prayers so that in the end we combat worry and rejoice in the Lord?

Beginning Sunday, February 1, join us for 28 Days of Prayer for the *Built on Truth* Campaign:

DAY 1: Pray for peace in our hearts as we endure whatever this world brings and that we will work together, encouraging one another in love knowing the Lord is overall.

"In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." – John 16:33

DAY 2: Pray for the many decisions yet to be made in the building project –for individuals seeking guidance for how they should participate, construction planning and oversight, scheduling, final design issues, and protection that the process would not distract us all from that which is important.
