4) Weekday Application Questions

a) EQUIP — Why does Joshua 3 place the Ark of the Covenant at the center of the narrative, and how does this reveal what it means for God to “go before” His people?

b) ENGAGE — Where might God be calling you to step forward in obedience so that others can see that the living God is truly among His people?

c) EXALT — How does seeing the Lord as “the living God” (vs. 10) and “the Lord of all the earth” (vs. 13) shape the way you trust, worship, and revere Him today?

d) Here is your “One Thing” for this week: Follow the Lord forward in faith, trusting that His presence goes before you—even when you have never passed this way before.
