- a) **EQUIP** — Where else in Scripture does God command His people to build rhythms of remembrance (e.g., Passover, Sabbath, the Lord's Supper), and what do those patterns teach us about how God forms faithful generations?
- b) **ENGAGE** — Joshua 4 says the memorial was built so "all the peoples of the earth may know." How can telling specific stories of God's faithfulness in your life open doors for Gospel conversations this week?
- c) **EXALT** — How does reflecting on the mighty hand of the LORD in your past deepen your trust and worship of Him in the present?
- d) **Here is your "One Thing" for this week:** This week, choose one specific act of God's faithfulness in your life, create a tangible reminder (i.e., memorial stones) of it, and intentionally share that story with someone.
