4) Weekday Application Questions

- a) **EQUIP** — Read Genesis 17 and Deuteronomy 30:15–20. Why is circumcision not merely a ritual, but a covenant sign tied to land, seed, and blessing? How does Joshua 5 show that covenant identity must be renewed before covenant promises are possessed?
- b) **ENGAGE** — How does remembering redemption (Passover / The Lord's Supper) shape the way we live as witnesses in a fallen, sinful world?
- c) **EXALT**— Joshua fell on his face before the Captain of the Lord's host. What does it look like for you to move from asking "Is God on my side?" to bowing before His holiness? How does reverence for the Holy One fuel obedience?
- d) **Here is your "One Thing" for this week:** Before you seek victory, let God build obedience within you — remember who you belong to, remember what God has done, and bow before your true Commander.
