a) **EQUIP** — How has the power of God been displayed in Joshua 1–5? How is it displayed in Joshua 6? Describe some of the theological lessons the author wants the reader to take away from these chapters.

b) **ENGAGE** — Since all the city was “devoted to destruction,” how is the reader supposed to understand the place that Rahab is given among the people of God? What does that insight teach us about evangelism today?

c) **EXALT**— How does the story of Joshua 6 reveal that God does not exercise His power in an arbitrary way? How does God’s power lead to blessing? How does His power bring about judgment?

d) **Here is your “One Thing” for this week:** The victory belongs to the LORD. The obedience belongs to you. Obey what He has revealed — and trust Him with the outcome.
