Our Vision

Introducing *Built on Truth*,

a three-year campaign to expand and enhance our campus by building a 14,000 square foot facility dedicated to teaching the Bible.

Built on Truth is the foundational phase of our church's Facilities Master Plan, a total vision for how our campus will take shape and support the ministry of our church over the next 10–20 years and long into the future.

Why Built on Truth?

We live in an age where truth is questioned, redefined, and ignored. We live in a world where convictions are traded for comfort and sound doctrine is seen as optional. We live in a world of chaos and confusion. But at Grace Bible Church, we believe the truth still matters. God's Word still speaks. And the church still has a responsibility to teach, train, and send people who will stand firm in a tumultuous world.

Since 1954, God has uniquely positioned Grace Bible Church to teach, train, and send disciples who stand firmly on His Word. For decades, our church has been shaped by a commitment to biblical truth and intentional discipleship across all ages. Now, we have the opportunity to expand that mission for generations to come.

Why Now?

Grace Bible Church welcomes on average 650 people of all ages to our campus on Sunday mornings. We host ministry events, Bible studies, outside organizations, and more every single day of the week. Our campus has served us well and we are grateful for God's provision and the ministry that fills our halls. However, we are experiencing symptoms of thriving ministries at a growing church—overlapping room schedules, limited capacity for hosting all-church events, and deterioration issues in older sections of our buildings, to name a few.

Recognizing this over a decade ago, Grace Bible Church's leadership determined that it was time to begin thinking about a long-term plan for the future of our facilities. The question resurfaced again after Pastor Jace Cloud was appointed Senior Pastor in 2021. The challenge was this: How does Grace Bible Church remain true to the biblical principles we've carried since our founding while preparing for the future ministry God is leading us to? With input from our congregation, a vision of what could be, reliable data for projected growth, prayerful planning, and in partnership with architects from Omniplan, a master plan was created.

This master plan is a phased approach that will allow us to step with wisdom and discernment into the ministry God is calling us to now and in the future. There is an incredible opportunity before us to maximize our ministry impact across our entire campus for generations to come, and we believe there is no better time than now to begin the foundational phase in faith.

Together, let's invest in Truth and ensure that Grace Bible Church will forever be Built on Truth.

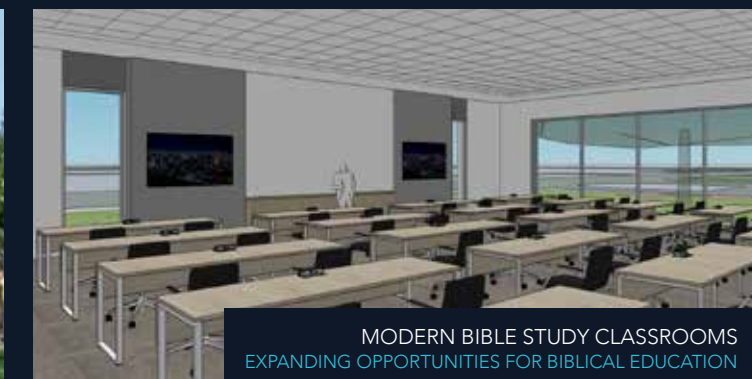

Building Project Scope



- Expand our campus footprint by building a **14,000 sqft. Biblical Education Building** south of the Sanctuary on the Northaven lawn.
- **Relocate, expand, and enhance Bible classrooms and group meeting areas** to the new building.
The current plans include eight classrooms of varying sizes for small to large groups, an indoor corridor from the new east parking lot entrance to our current Sanctuary lobby, a second Welcome Desk and lobby, necessary storage rooms, and additional restrooms.
- Create a purposeful **Community Commons** with a park-like setting that invites outdoor fellowship for all ages, including a new playground for children, a recreation area, and a covered patio with seating.
- **A new courtyard** between the Sanctuary and new building will further enhance our green spaces across campus by adding a quiet space for prayer, reflection, and unhurried conversation throughout the week.
- Finally, *Built on Truth* will support necessary **audiovisual updates** to our Sanctuary systems that will enhance the worship experience and bring us up to date with current technology if funds are available.



PLEASE NOTE: Designs are conceptual and may change as the project develops.

Project Cost:

\$8.5 Million

This new building will not be a monument to the past. It will be a mission station for the future. It will be a place where the next generation is equipped with the Word. It will be a place **where seekers become students, where students become servants, and where servants become leaders**, missionaries, elders, and everyday men and women of God who carry the gospel wherever they go.

Fulfilling this vision will require all of us.

It calls for gratitude as we remember God's faithfulness to our church over the past 70+ years. It calls for unity in prayer, asking the Lord to help us discern His purposes and trust His plans for the future. It also calls for personal prayer—inviting God to show each of us how He desires us to participate in this vision. Above all, it calls for faithful obedience, so that together we may fully step into our ministry potential. Every generation must decide: Will the truth stop with us, or will we entrust it to the next generation?

“If Bible classes, both Sunday mornings and throughout the week, are one of the primary places where God’s Word quietly and consistently shapes the beliefs of our church, what would it mean to give them space that reflects that importance?

A dedicated Bible Education Building would allow learning to happen with clarity and focus, creating spaces where people can listen carefully, ask real questions, and be formed by Scripture rather than competing voices.

Such a facility would not simply make our Bible classes more comfortable; it would make them more fruitful. It would allow the church to offer new classes for different seasons of life and levels of biblical understanding, strengthen existing classes through better focus and continuity, and develop future teachers by giving them a clear place to be trained, supported, and sent. In a world full of voices shaping how people think and live, this would be a tangible commitment to letting God’s Word do its steady, life-giving work among us.”

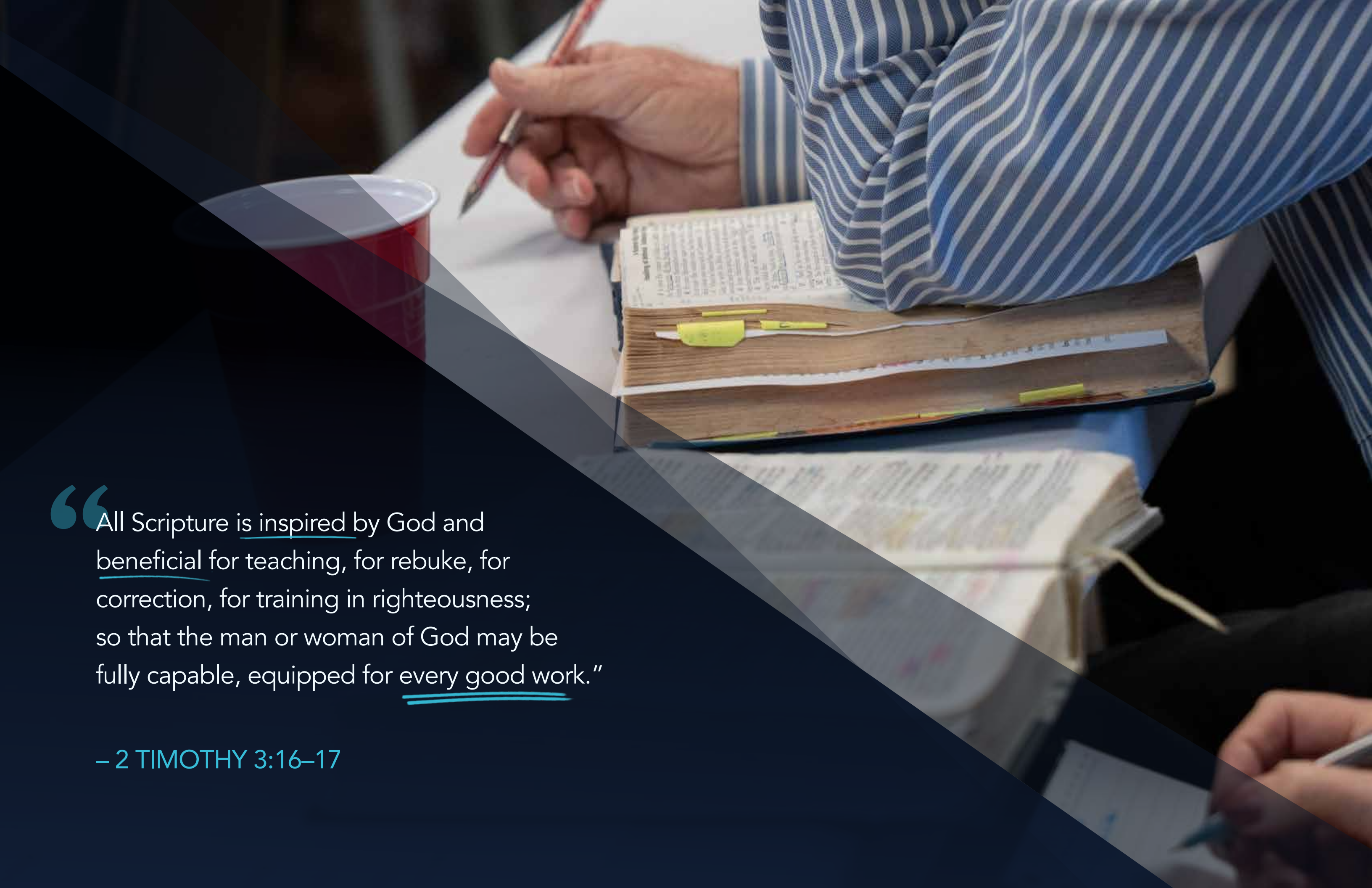

Why Pray?

The renowned 19th-century preacher and theologian Charles Spurgeon was once asked, “Which is more important, reading Scripture or prayer?” He replied, “Which is more important, breathing in or breathing out?”

Scripture references prayer more than 650 times, first appearing in Genesis 4:26, when people began to “call on the name of the Lord.” Prayer is central to the Christian life—it deepens our relationship with God, grants us access to the Father to confess our sins, express gratitude, and seek help and guidance. Through prayer, we resist temptation, ask for wisdom, and intercede on behalf of others.

Prayer is both a command and a vital practice that aligns our will with God’s, bringing us strength, peace, and provision. Many faithful believers before us prayed—Abraham (Genesis 12:8), Isaac (Genesis 25:21), Moses (Exodus 33:18), Mary (Luke 1:46–56), and Jesus Himself (John 17:9). Jesus also taught His disciples how to pray in Matthew 6, showing us that prayer is the believer’s ongoing conversation with the Father about every matter of life.

Prayer leads us into the deepest and highest work of the human spirit, drawing us into continual communion with God. In true prayer, we begin to think His thoughts,

desire what He desires, love what He loves, and will what He wills. Just as breath sustains life, prayer will sustain the ministry of Grace Bible Church.

That is why we have created a 28-day Built on Truth Prayer Guide to help you connect with God as you prepare to be a part of *Built on Truth*. Let your heart, soul, mind, and body catch the vision from God for how He would have you participate in His work of transforming our community through His Gospel.

Each day, beginning February 1, will contain a short passage of scripture along with a prayer prompt so that in just a few minutes a day, we can all engage with God and discover where He is leading Grace Bible Church. So, let us pray.

Join Us For 28 Days of Prayer

DAY 1 Pray for peace in our hearts as we endure whatever this world brings and that we will work together, encouraging one another in love knowing the Lord is over all.

"In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." – John 16:33

DAY 2 Pray for the many decisions yet to be made in the building project – for individuals seeking guidance for how they should participate, construction planning and oversight, scheduling, final design issues, and protection that the process would not distract us all from that which is important.

"If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, Who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him." – James 1:5

DAY 3 Pray for the unsaved to hear the Word and learn of the gift of salvation as Grace Bible Church continues to provide clear preaching and teaching.

"How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?" – Rom. 10:14

DAY 4 Pray for those who will gather together to hear the teaching of the Scriptures as Grace Bible Church, join in fellowship, and use their gifts in the years to come.

DAY 5 Pray that our church leadership stays true to the Word of God to guide each of us to hear, "Well done, good and faithful servant."

"You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master." – Matt. 25:21

DAY 6 Pray that the coming days will bring opportunities to display God's faithfulness in the building campaign fundraising, construction, and use of the resources He provides.

"The Lord's acts of mercy indeed do not end, For His compassions do not fail. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness." – Lam. 3:22-23

DAY 7 Pray that Grace Bible Church will be a beacon of hope to the lost and through the teaching at our church many will be saved and grow in all grace and truth.

DAY 8 Pray that all who enter Grace Bible Church will experience the mercy of God through us.

- DAY 12** Pray that our hearts would be open before the Lord leading to understanding of all His ways.
"For they had not understood about the loaves, because their heart was hardened." – Mark 6:52
- DAY 13** Pray for the teaching of the Word at Grace Bible Church to make known how great is our God.
"Oh, give thanks to the Lord! Call upon His name; make known His deeds among the peoples!" – Psalm 105:1

- DAY 14** Pray for the next generation of believers at Grace Bible Church, that though they do not seek God, they will find Him.
"I was made manifest to those who did not ask for Me." – Rom. 10:20
- DAY 15** Pray that our congregation will grow in knowledge leading to faithfulness to the Lord.
"Other seeds fell into the good soil, and as they grew up and increased, they yielded a crop and produced thirty, sixty, and a hundred times as much." – Mark 4:8
- DAY 16** Pray that the priorities of leadership will be aligned with God's plan for our church.
"For we do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your bondservants for Jesus' sake." – 2 Cor. 4:5
- DAY 17** Pray that the teaching at Grace Bible Church will be clear and true, giving hope that encourages obedience.
"Prepare the way, take the stumbling block out of the way of My people." – Isa. 57:14
- DAY 18** Pray for the love Jesus has for us at Grace Bible Church will be apparent to each of us so we will follow Him in all we do.
"When He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd." – Matt. 9:36
- DAY 19** Pray for Grace Bible Church to seek revival in our nation, leading many to come to know the truth leading to saving faith.
"The Word of God grew and multiplied." – Acts 12:24

DAY 20 Pray that each of us would fill our hearts with the Word and live it out each day.

"And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up." – Deut. 6:6, 7

DAY 21 Pray that the classrooms in the new building would be filled with those yearning to learn and learning to share the truth with others.

DAY 22 Pray for each generation at Grace Bible Church, children, youth, young adults, and older adults to know the Word and grow in faith.

"That from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus." – 2 Tim. 3:15

DAY 23 Pray that the relationships among those at Grace Bible Church would be strengthened to encourage one another in love and good works.

DAY 24 Pray for compassion toward those who do not know Jesus, do not follow Jesus, do not love Jesus, that they will learn of Him and repent.

Campaign **FAQs**

1. What is the cost of *Built on Truth* and what is included?

The estimated cost of *Built on Truth*, the foundational phase of the facilities master plan is \$8.5 million. It includes the new Biblical Education Building with an east entrance and covered walkway from the parking lot, updates and optimization of the adjacent outdoor gathering space, and Sanctuary audiovisual upgrades.

2. When will the construction begin? How long will it take?

Lead times for construction projects in Dallas vary, so it is impossible to say exactly when construction will begin. First, the Planning Committee will work alongside the architects to complete design and development in order to produce construction documents for permitting. The estimated time for this step is seven to nine months. Once construction begins, it is estimated the project will take approximately 15 months to complete. Our hope is to open the doors to the new Biblical Education Building in late 2027.

3. Why does *Built on Truth* focus on education space—and why must it happen first?

Once the facilities master plan was complete, we asked the architects to give us a phased approach to implementing the plan without displacing or requiring any of our current ministry to cease while expanding or renovating our facilities. Based on their recommendation, the first step in implementing our master plan is the focus of *Built on Truth*. It is the foundational step. It assures us that our current ministries will not be displaced while we grow and build.

We are excited that this new building will expand our footprint and ministry opportunity on Sunday mornings and beyond (e.g., added classes, conferences, outside ministries, partnerships with DTS, etc.) that we are currently unable to host due to space and functional limitations.

4. Why can't current or soon-to-be-vacant spaces (Grace Academy, old sanctuary, empty classrooms) meet these needs?

In the planning process, the allocation and location of ministry spaces was strategically chosen in order to meet the needs identified for projected growth in our ministries. Only utilizing the vacated space would necessitate additional new building and remodeling projects to accommodate our projected needs and bring the space up to modern standards with code compliance and design.

We are not looking at the short-term, but rather the long-term. This master plan assures that Grace Bible Church will have adequate facilities and spaces to continue our ministries both now and long into the future. Grace Kids will be able to reclaim shared spaces and expand possibilities for serving our youngest Bible learners. Grace Students would have dedicated space instead of overlapping with all other ministries. Our administrative offices would be sufficient to centralize our staff and add places to collaborate.

5. How will we pay for *Built on Truth*?

Through gifts given by Grace attendees. We are aiming to have the full \$8.5 million raised over the next three years. Currently, Grace has no indebtedness and ended 2025 in a strong financial position.

Historically, Grace borrowed money to help fund construction of the current sanctuary. Our Elder board will track the total commitments throughout the campaign and pray/discern if it is wise to borrow money to ensure we have the resources to fully fund *Built on Truth*.

6. How long do I give?

Built on Truth is a maximum three-year commitment. During this campaign, you will be given an opportunity to complete a commitment card. You will be encouraged to turn in the completed card on Commitment Sunday, February 15th and to make a first gift on First Fruits Offering Sunday, February 22nd. After this initial offering, the three-year commitment giving will begin.

7. What about my regular giving? How will ongoing operating, maintenance, and staffing costs be covered without harming existing ministries?

Your commitment to *Built on Truth* should be an amount that God leads you to give over and above your regular giving. We must remain faithful to our regular giving to the General & Missions Fund so that day-to-day ministry can continue.

Based on growth projections, we are expecting new attendees and givers to help cover new operating and maintenance costs associated with expanding facilities. We have seen steady growth that supports these projections.

8. What is the overall estimated cost to complete the master plan?

The overall cost of the master plan is difficult to estimate at this time. It was created in conjunction with OmniPlan to account for church growth and is a vision for how we want the campus to look in 10-20 years. Grace Bible Church Leadership are committed to wise stewardship and prayerful planning as we move forward with each phase.

9. Will my contribution be made public?

Absolutely not. Only the total of all commitments received will be announced. In keeping with our giving policy, your contribution will only be known by our accountant.

10. Will I be coerced or pressured to give financially?

Absolutely not. Each member will be expected to give what God leads them to give because they are a part of the body. Not equal gifts, but equal sacrifice will be asked of all. We know that where God leads, He will provide. We are not planning to make any further asks to give during this phase unless we are projecting to be short of the giving goal.
