5) Weekday Application Questions

a) EQUIP — Trace the pattern of temptation in Joshua 7:21 (“I saw... I coveted... I took... I concealed”). Where do we see a similar pattern elsewhere in Scripture (Genesis 3; Second Samuel 11; James 1:14–15)?

b) ENGAGE — Joshua was concerned about God’s reputation among the nations (Josh 7:9). How can our obedience—or disobedience—affect how others perceive the God we claim to follow?

c) EXALT— Ask God to search your heart (Psalm 139:23–24) and reveal anything that needs to be confessed and surrendered to Him.

d) Here is your “One Thing” for this week: The victory belongs to the LORD — but hidden sin will rob His people of that victory. So bring your sin into the light, and let God restore what sin has taken away.
