5) Weekday Application Questions

- a) **EQUIP** —Read Colossians 2:9–15 again this week and make a list of everything that is already true of you “in Christ.” Ask: What does this passage say about who Jesus is? What does it say has already happened to me? Where am I living as though that is not true? Then, each day, take one phrase— “made alive,” “forgiven,” “complete,” “victorious”— and preach it to yourself.
- b) **ENGAGE** — Who in your life is still living as though sin, guilt, or death has the final word? This week, look for an opportunity to share the simple truth of the gospel: That Jesus died for sin, rose from the dead, and offers new life to all who believe. You don’t need all the answers. You just need to point people to the One who has already won the victory.
- c) **EXALT**— Spend time this week thanking God for what He has already done for you in Christ. Not asking for something new — but praising Him for what is already true.
- d) **Here is your “One Thing” for this week:** Stop living as though something is missing— Jesus is Lord, and in Him you are complete, new, alive, and victorious.
