#### 4) Weekday Application Questions

a) **EQUIP** — Trace how confidence in the LORD develops in this chapter (vv. 7–8, 24–25). What specific actions of God reinforce Israel's courage? How does this shape a biblical theology of divine warfare and human obedience?

b) **ENGAGE** — Who in your life is currently facing a battle where they feel overwhelmed or hopeless? How can you point them to the God who fights for His people—not just in circumstances, but ultimately through the gospel of Jesus Christ?

c) **EXALT**— How does Joshua 10 elevate your view of God's sovereignty over creation, history, and human affairs? Take time this week to worship Him specifically as Divine Warrior—One who commands heaven and earth and fights for His people.

d) **Here is your "One Thing" for this week:** Pray one bold, specific, seemingly "impossible" prayer this week—and write it down. Then watch for how God responds, trusting that He hears, He acts, and He fights for His people in His perfect way.
