b) **ENGAGE** — Who needs to hear the invitation to run to Christ—the true refuge—and how will you engage them?

c) **EXALT**— What is currently at the functional center of your life—and how do you re-center it on God?

d) **Here is your “One Thing” for this week:** Trust God’s Word enough to obey it—fully. Because not one word has failed, you can trust Him—so step forward in obedience.
