#### 4) Weekday Application Questions

a) EQUIP — Read Joshua 23–24 as one unit. How do Joshua’s two farewell addresses complement one another? What does Joshua 23 emphasize about covenant warning, and what does Joshua 24 emphasize about covenant renewal?

b) ENGAGE — Why does Joshua rehearse Israel’s story before calling them to serve the LORD? How can rehearsing God’s faithfulness in your own life become a natural bridge for sharing the Gospel with someone else?

c) EXALT— Why is serving the LORD incompatible with idolatry? What rival loves or lesser allegiances most often compete for your worship, trust, or obedience?

d) Here is your “One Thing” for this week: Choose Today to Serve the LORD! Get a piece of paper and write down your “Top-10 Life Priorities.” Then prayerfully ask: Which of these good gifts is most likely to become a rival god in my heart?
