3) Weekday Application Questions

a) **EQUIP** — Paul says truth leads to godliness. Evaluate your life. What specific area of your conduct reveals a gap between what you know and how you live?

b) **ENGAGE** — Titus served in a corrupt culture. Where has the surrounding culture pressured you to compromise your biblical convictions? How can you remain faithful while still engaging others with love and grace?

c) **EXALT**— Spend time thanking God that He is the God who cannot lie. How does God's truthfulness strengthen your confidence in His promises?

d) **Here is your "One Thing" for this week:** Because God's grace has saved you, allow God's grace to transform you. Identify one area this week where your beliefs need to become your behavior—and surrender that area to Christ.
