a) **EQUIP** — According to Titus 1:5–16, what is the relationship between sound doctrine and godly character? Why does Paul refuse to separate the two concepts?

b) **ENGAGE** — What are some ways people can become “troublemakers” in a church without realizing it? How can we instead become people who strengthen and unify the body of Christ in our words, beliefs, and actions?

c) **EXALT** — How does Jesus perfectly model the kind of integrity Paul describes in this passage—where actions and words completely agree?

d) **Here is your “One Thing” for this week:** Be a truth teller, not a troublemaker. Hold fast to the truth, refuse to spread error, and use your words to strengthen Christ’s church rather than damage it.
